

Selected Reading: Luke 13:31–35

Jesus' heart breaks with God's own desire for peace.

Discipleship Thought: Jesus' heart breaks with God's own desire for a city that's lost its way, a city that has turned its back on its vocation to be the light of the world:

'O Jerusalem, how often I have longed to gather your children together, as a hen gathers her chicks under her wings, but you were not willing!' ~ Luke 13.34.

The image is of a mother hen who knows destruction is coming, but the chicks will not come to the place of restoration and safety. Jesus' determination to go to Jerusalem reveals his willingness to suffer – for wayward Jerusalem as the one who sees the danger coming. To go ahead of the people and take the full force of the powers of destruction upon himself in order that God's people could be renewed and rediscover their vocation. Picture the mother hen again, scorched and blackened as fire sweeps through, with live chicks sheltering beneath her wings. Picture also a future day when people will say,

'Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord.'

Prayer: When, O God, we search the deep longings of our hearts, when we listen to the quiet desires of our souls, it is you, O God, all you; you are our light and salvation.

When others abandon us and our worlds fall apart, you are there to pick up the pieces.

You put us together again, and somehow, a masterpiece! Good as new.
