Selected Reading: Mark 10:46-52 - 'Go, your faith has made you well'

Discipleship Thought: When Jesus met Bartimaeus, it must have been obvious that the man was blind, so why does Jesus ask Bartimaeus, 'What do you want me to do for you?' One possibility is that Jesus wants to pay attention not to a 'blind man,' someone defined by what he lacks, but that he wants to meet Bartimaeus (one of the few people Jesus healed with not only a name but a linage — 'son of Timaeus'). Perhaps Jesus does not want to presume that he knows what this particular individual wants from him. Perhaps Jesus's disciples.

on hearing Jesus's interaction with Bartimaeus, also began to see a particular individual and not a condition; they saw a man and remembered, as we might, that Jesus sees each of us as individuals and asks the same profound question of us, 'What do you want me to do for you?'

**Prayer:** The psalm tells us that God restored the people.

That restoration was so glorious, that people felt they were living a dream.

Their mouths were filled with laughter and their tongues with shouts of joy.

People experienced the goodness of God.

God of all goodness, we, too, in all of our days, are recipients of grace upon grace.
