Welcome, we are glad you have joined us in Worship. You are invited to join us for morning tea following the Service.

Selected Reading: Luke 4:21-30 - God loves and extends grace to outsiders, too.

Discipleship Thought: Jesus does something dangerous. He reads a wellknown passage from Isaiah to the hometown crowd; only he omits the key reference to God carrying out vengeance on Israel's enemies. He's left announcing grace to all, completely disregarding the profound tension and the strain these relationships have known. Jesus knows the parochial interest of the group. So, he introduces counter-narratives from within their own traditions, stories of God extending healing and grace to widows, Gentiles, the unclean, and those of low status – outsiders, all of them, yet treated by God as insiders. These stories only seem to infuriate the crowd further. They drive him to the edge of a cliff; somehow, he manages to slip away unharmed, going on his way – his unique way, a way of grace and peace, so different from the ways of the crowd. Jesus reminds us of how offensive grace is and how dangerous peacemaking really can be.

Prayer: O beautiful God!

You lean our way with such kindness; you are open and available, always ready to listen and protect.

When we find our way into valleys of shame and boulevards of brokenness, you steer us on the right course again.

You, God, are our hope, and we trust in you.
